## ACT Team

**Assertive Community  
Treatment for Adults**

## What is the ACT Team?

The Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) team is a 24-hour, seven days per week service provided by a multi-disciplinary team to adults who require intensive counseling, case management, and medication management support.

## Eligibility

Adults are eligible for ACT services if they have the following:

- Diagnosis of Major Mental Illness
- Repeated psychiatric hospitalizations or crisis contacts
- Child has recently been discharged from psychiatric hospitalization or residential treatment with a documented high probability of decompensating in the absence of ACT services
- MaineCare Coverage

## Treatment Services

The ACT team includes a psychiatrist, a mental health nurse, licensed Master's level clinicians, and counselors/case managers. The team provides:

- Assessment and treatment planning
- Crisis management
- Individual counseling in the home
- Family education
- Case management services
- Medication management services
- Substance Abuse Treatment
- Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling & Support
